



Our Standard Nursery Fees

Our standard nursery fees apply to families who are not accessing funded childcare, as well as to any additional hours or sessions booked outside of a child's funded entitlement.

Our fees reflect the full cost of providing high-quality childcare, with experienced staff, freshly prepared meals and a wide range of learning experiences included throughout the day. From exploring the farm and caring for the animals to outdoor learning, creative play and discovering nature, every day is filled with opportunities for children to learn, explore and grow.

If you are booking privately funded sessions, or would like to add extra days or hours alongside your funded childcare, these will be charged at our standard nursery rates.

We understand that every family's childcare needs are different, so we're always happy to talk through your options and help you find the right balance of sessions, funding and costs for your family.

Childcare for Eligible Working Families (based on 30 hours funded childcare stretched across 51 weeks)

We're proud to offer childcare for eligible working families. Government funding provides eligible families with up to 30 hours of funded childcare per week for 38 weeks of the year. Rather than limiting this funding to term time, our council allows us to stretch your total annual funded entitlement across 51 weeks, helping families access funded childcare throughout most of the year. When stretched, 30 hours of weekly funding equates to approximately 22 funded hours per week.

As funding is stretched across 51 weeks, one week each year falls outside the funded period. During this week, Standard Fees will apply to the days and sessions your child attends.

If your child is fully funded, attendance during this week is optional. You will only be charged Standard Fees for the days your child attends. If you choose not to attend during this week, no fee will be charged.

Many families choose to use their funded hours across a mix of full or half-day sessions. The examples below show typical combinations and their approximate weekly costs. These costs may include:

- Additional childcare hours attended above the funded entitlement of 22.35 hours per week;
- The enrichment fee, £12,50 per funded session attended, which covers additional activities, resources, meals, consumables and experiences that go beyond the standard early years curriculum, including outdoor learning, farm visits and nature-based adventures.

Funded childcare can be accessed during the following session times:

Funded full-day session: 8:00am–6:00pm

Funded morning session: 8:00am–1:00pm

Funded afternoon session: 1:00pm–6:00pm

Childcare for Eligible Working Families (based on 15 hours funded childcare stretched across 51 weeks)

From the term after your child's third birthday every child in England is entitled to 15 hours of funded childcare per week, for 38 weeks of the year (term time). When "stretched" across the 51 weeks, this works out as 11.17 funded hours each week.

Eligible two-year-olds may also apply for this funding. Funding starts the term after your child turns two and after you receive and validate an official code or local authority approval. Check your criteria and get your code via [GOV.UK Childcare Support](https://www.gov.uk/childcare-support). As with all funding you must apply the term before you plan to use the hours.

As the council allows funded hours to be stretched across 51 weeks of the year, there is one week each year that falls outside the funded period. During this week, Standard Fees will apply to the days and sessions your child attends.

If your child is fully funded, attendance during this week is optional. You will therefore only be charged Standard Fees for the days your child attends, if you choose not to attend on any of these days, no fee will be charged.

Many families use these funded hours alongside paid sessions to create a weekly routine that suits them best. The examples below show typical combinations and their approximate weekly costs, which include:

- Additional childcare hours attended above the funded entitlement of 11.17 hours per week;
- Optional early and late club fees if you would like extend the times of the funded session to the full nursery opening times, and
- The enrichment fee, £12,50 per funded session attended, which covers additional activities, resources, meals, consumables and experiences that go beyond the standard early years curriculum, including outdoor learning, farm visits and nature-based adventures.

Funded full-day session: 8:00am–6:00pm

Funded morning session: 8:00am–1:00pm

Funded afternoon session: 1:00pm–6:00pm

Frequently Asked Questions

How to I Access Funded Hours?

This varies depending on your child's age. To apply for funding and check your eligibility, please visit: [Check your eligibility for free childcare](#). As with all funding you must apply the term before you plan to use the hours.

Do I need to put down a deposit when I join?

Yes, we ask for a £150 deposit to hold your place and agree a start date. £100 of this comes off your first month's fees, but £50 is non-refundable admin fee. Fully funded children are not required to pay the £50 admin fee.

Do you currently have a waiting list?

Yes, we currently have a waiting list across all age groups. We encourage families to register their interest early to secure a place.

What are your opening times?

Nursery opening hours: 7:30am–6:30pm

Funded childcare sessions: 8:00am–6:00pm

We offer Early and Late Clubs at additional cost to extend the funded sessions the full nursery opening times. The costs vary by age; Under 3's £5.40, Over 3's £4.59

Is there a minimum number of sessions required?

Yes, we require a minimum of two sessions per week. This can be two full days, one full day and one half day, or two half-day sessions.

You stretch your funding over 51 weeks, what about the 52nd week?

Government funding provides eligible families with up to 30 hours of funded childcare per week for 38 weeks of the year. Rather than limiting this funding to term time, we stretch total annual funded entitlement across 51 weeks, helping families access funded childcare throughout most of the year.

As funding is stretched across 51 weeks, one week each year falls outside the funded period.

During this week, Standard Fees will apply to the days and sessions your child attends.

If your child is fully funded, attendance during this week is optional. You will only be charged Standard Fees for the days your child attends. If you choose not to attend during this week, no fee will be charged.

Are bank holidays chargeable?

Yes, if your child normally attends on that day, the session will still be fully chargeable.

What's your notice period?

We require four weeks' notice if you're leaving the nursery or making any permanent changes to your child's sessions. This allows us to manage our monthly invoicing and maintain smooth transitions for families and staff.

If we go on holiday, do we have to pay?

Yes, all scheduled sessions remain fully chargeable, even if your child is away on holiday.

Enrichment Package

At Farm Day Nurseries, we pride ourselves on giving young children the very best start in life. All of our farm-based nurseries offer rich, meaningful learning experiences, including daily trips to the farm and access to natural resources that make our settings truly unique. We also ensure that children enjoy high-quality meals, snacks, drinks, and essential consumables throughout the day. We offer the government funded childcare, which is free at point of delivery, however this funding does not cover the cost of these enhancements. In order to access these items, we ask parent for an optional enrichment fee. We hope that once you see everything this includes, you'll agree it offers exceptional value and supports the outstanding experience we provide.

Enrichment Package

To make nursery life easier for families, we offer an Enrichment Package that bundles together all the extras that funding does not cover. Most families choose this option, as it ensures children can:

- Enjoy daily farm visits and VIP learning experiences with their friends.
- Receive fresh, healthy meals and snacks prepared by our in house chef each day.
- Benefit from all-inclusive care items such as nappies, nappy cream, and sun cream – meaning you don't have to bring these in yourself.

- Convenience: No need to remember pre-made packed lunches, snacks, nappies, and all items listed below.
- Value: One fixed, simple fee that covers everything, rather than separate payments.
- Experience: Your child won't miss out on unique learning opportunities such as farm visits and hands-on activities that are central to our nursery approach.



Our Enrichment Fees

What Costs are Not Covered by the Funding:

Essential Supplies & Care

- Nappies, wipes, sun cream, nappy sacks

Meals & Nutrition

- Chef-prepared meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner, snacks).
- Formula, milk, milk alternatives)

Creative & Sensory Play

- “Enrichment” versions of play, e.g.: Baking & food play (consumables).
- Specialist light tables,
- Home learning kits, book clubs, take-home packs.

Outdoor Learning & Nature Play

- Mini Farmer sessions
- Consumables like gardening equipment, greenhouse projects.
- Farm Trips
- VIP farm experiences.
- Safety equipment for trips (high-vis etc).

Seasonal & Celebration Events

- Christmas fetes, Halloween, graduation parties, keepsakes.
- Special visits (e.g. Santa).

Administration & Parent Engagement

- Online invoicing

Our Enrichment Fees

Breakdown of Enrichment Fee

Subject to new guidance from the Department of Education, please see the breakdown of costs that the enrichment fee covers.

The Enrichment Fee contributes towards a range of optional additional goods, services and experiences available at Godstone Farm Day Nursery.

The current full costs of these items are:

- Food: £14.00 (full funded day) / £9.00 (half funded day)
- Consumables: £5.00
- Farm trips and experiences: £10.00

Our voluntary Enrichment Fee is £12.50 per funded session covers all of the costs above, regardless of whether your child attends a full or half funded day.

Parents who choose not to pay the Enrichment Fee, can chose to opt in/out of the individual elements listed above. Instead, they will need to make alternative arrangements for the items and experiences covered by the fee, as detailed in our Enrichment Fee Exclusions Policy. Please speak to the Nursery Manager if you would like to discuss these arrangements.
